- 3. Decorations: Candyland squares throughout the Multipurpose Room
 - a. Yolanda will be there starting at 8am to set-up
 - b. Greta will create a SignUp Genius for volunteers, in three 1-hour long shifts starting at 8am, and then 2 slots for 6pm and 7pm.
- 4. Photographer is booked and is donating a 5x7 for each couple
 - a. Photo booth in addition to photographer? Yes, gives something else for kids to do and is instant.
 - b. Hand out numbers when people check-in to manage picture line. DJ will call out sets of numbers.
- 5. Activities?
 - a. Candy necklace making table? Yes
 - b. Possibly hand out goodie bags with a frame to decorate? Yes
 - c. Dad's dance contest?
 - i. DJ usually has "activities" for guests to do. Yolanda will ask the DJ to play some games/group songs.
- 6. Desserts?
 - a. Keep mentioning the need for donations in Tuesday Talk/Friday Folder/FB
 - b. Currently 20 couples are signed up to bring desserts
 - c. Charis will email those who have paid via PayPal if they are bringing desserts.
- 7. Two special parking spots need to be set up in the loop for VIPs
 - a. Let them go to the front of the photography line

- 3. Two fields available: One for cornhold tourney and one for softball or kickball (just for pickup games)
- 4. If we get 100 people to go (at \$35 a ticket), we should break even...we just don't want to lose money!
