1. Monthly Financials
 - a. Treasurer Report –

2. Fundraising
 - a. Hands Free Fundraising Update: Received \$164.83 from AmazonSmile - we will continue to promote this with holiday shopping going on
 - b. Water Bottle Stickers: We will soon start selling in the front office for \$1 through Gail and people must have exact cash. Could advertise as a stocking stuffer for students.
 - c. Marquee Birthday Announcements: These are now available for purchase on the PTC website for \$10. Purchasers must complete google form and submit payment 1 week in advance of birthday to provide enough time for data entry into the system.
 - i. Student's first name and first initial will be shown
 - ii. If student has a summer birthday, we can post their birthday message the week before school is out for summer or the first week back to school
 - d. Jaguar Jam Planning
 - i. Options for us to choose from are:
 1. Virtual Fun Run: Boosterthon provides soundtrack and students do run on their own time at home
 2. DanceFit Event: Similar to JustDance video game, students participate in dances to "run" their laps.
 - ii. Working with Mrs. Mochrie & Teacher PLC leadership to see how we can logistically hold the final Dancefit event on campus in the classrooms and still follow District guidelines for on campus instruction at this time.

December Planning

1. Toy Drive (11/30-12/09)
 - a. The PTC will host a toy drive benefiting Toys for Tots 11/30-12/09, and will deliver the donations to the Martha Riley Library after school on 12/09.
 - b. Junction families can donate a new, unwrapped toy and bring it to their classroom or the front office. We are reusing the food donation boxes that Staples donated for each classroom. Additional boxes will be put in the front office for champions students and other donations brought in.
 - c. The Roseville Fire Department is still accepting Toys for Tots donations this year, but in a different manner than in the past due to COVID-19. They have specific locations set up to accept donations, and one of them is our local library - Martha Riley.
 - d. While they are accepting donations through Christmas, they have asked for donations by 12/09 if possible so the toys can be safely distributed in the appropriate channels

3. Teacher Appreciation: Greta will check with Yolanda on ideas for December and January.

Additional Updates/Miscellaneous

1. Room Parents – Jen emailed room parents to start discussions with teachers about winter parties and also reach out to families for donations for teacher gifts.
 - a. Guidelines for winter parties:
 - i. No volunteers are allowed in the classrooms
 - iii. Recommended activities for parties are art projects, movement activities and games. No food donations.
 - iv. All outside materials will need to be brought to the class 72 hrs before the party
