December Review

1. Toy Drive was a great success! Mrs. Mochrie received a nice email from the Martha Riley library thanking our school for our generosity and donations.
 - a. Erika and Greta will look into what Fire Station received our toys so we can inquire where they were distributed to.
2. Sami Circuit Family Night – The PTC is happy to provide another monthly event for our Junction families.
3. Teacher Appreciation –
 - a. Yolanda organized a staff appreciation breakfast for the last Friday before winter break and also for the Monday before school resumed. We followed a similar format that Chilton did with creating a signup genius and amazon wish list for Junction families to purchase from.
 - i. All items purchased followed District guidelines (grab and go, individually wrapped food and drink items).
 - ii. The PTC was able to get almost everything donated and kept our costs to around \$100.
 - b. Yolanda also purchased personalized Christmas decorations for the teachers online and those were distributed before the winter break.

3. Jaguar Jam Fundraising

a. \$10,000 goal!

b. Fundraising starts on 01/25, students gather pledges for the next 2 weeks, and the Jaguar Jam DanceFit Event will happen on 02/05.

c. All Junction students will have the opportunity to participate in the Jaguar Jam fundraising and event - on campus students and Champions students

i. On campus students will have kickoff, watch daily character videos and have the event within their classroom

ii. Champions students will be sent Choice Boards with video links that can be watched at home, including the DanceFit event.

iii. Both on campus and Champion students will sign up online through Boosterthon, utilize their fundraising platform, and will be eligible for all prizes.

d. Teachers are excited and 200% on board for this event! Suggested a fitness/sports dress up day for the actual day of the event.

e. Communications - we will start promoting next week online, in emails and on the marquee. Teachers will be sent information, schedule, etc the week of the 11th.

f. Student Prizes

i. Storage: They are currently in the PTC shed. Mrs. Mochrie and Michael will help us move the prizes to the multipurpose room so the PTC can access and we do not have to ask staff to help with prize distribution.

ii. Daily Distribution: Because of current District guidelines, volunteers are still not allowed on campus. Greta will come in at 7:30 each day and work with Nadia to prepare the daily prize bags for classes
