Treasury Report/Budget Update

1. The PTC received an Amazon Smile 2nd quarter donation of \$361.47. We have exceeded our budget goal for the school year!
2. RSP funding request: Mrs. Martinez from RSP has requested \$83.40 for purchasing a Soar to Success reader series for her classroom. This will be funded through the school donation line in the 2020-2021 PTC budget.
3. Red Robin Dine Out - We have not received our check and Greta is working with the corporate office to resolve the issue.

February Review

1. Blaze Dine Out (02/09) – The PTC will be receiving a check for \$117.08 from the recent dine out fundraiser.
2. Sami Circuit Family Night (02/10) - Thank you to Sami for another great event!
3. Valentine's Class Parties – Per Jen, things went smoothly and fun was had by all! The PTC is happy to be able to coordinate something fun in the classrooms for the students. Thank you to room parents for their help!
4. Kona Ice/Kona Cocoa Fundraiser (02/17) - We had a successful event with 203 konas/hot cocoa sold and will be receiving \$160 back! The PTC will plan to schedule a Kona Ice day in May before school concludes for the year.

Jaguar Jam Wrap Up

1. How did it go?
 - a. Our Jaguar Jam fundraiser was an amazing success with an estimated profit of over \$37,000 and \$2,461 in eligible corporate donations
 - b. Expenses were kept to a minimum - approx \$270

- c. Disneyland ticket winners (Mia K - Gill / Simret T - Roderick) have been notified. The popsicle party and Disney class fundraiser parties occurred on 02/19. Mrs. Mochrie will be performing for the students prior to the Spring Break.
 - d. Teacher feedback:
 - i. Feedback received overall was positive
 - ii. Enjoyed not having the extra assemblies and less class interruptions
 - iii. Boosterthon prize distribution with labeled bags worked well
 - iv. Enjoyed Disney virtual class parties
2. What are the next steps?
- a. Pay Boosterthon - expecting to receive Boosterthon invoice this week. Boosterthon's portion is estimated to be 25%.
 - b. Follow up with persons whose corporate match is still in eligible status
 - c. Fund remaining financial commitments from this year (classroom support budgets, office support, teacher appreciation, etc), plan for a starting budget for 2021-2022 board and then see where we end up number wise
 - i. Mrs. Mochrie is working with the PBIS team and the teacher PLC leadership team to identify school needs and research possibilities for future spending. One idea they are currently researching is refurbishing the playground and the playground equipment, with the understanding our school is on the radar for a total resurfacing of the blacktop within the next 3 years.
 - 1. PTC also suggested ideas of new outdoor seating and more outdoor activity items (playground balls, hula hoops, jump ropes etc.)

March Planning

- 1. Sami Circuit Family Night (03/10) - event begins at 6pm. Make sure to stay until the end of the event for the secret password. Enter the password on Sami's website after the event and be entered into a fun raffle!
- 2. Panera Dine Out (03/17) - we will be receiving 20% back from 4-7pm. Persons must use code **PRFUND** online or show the flyer when ordering in the restaurant.
- 3. 2021-2022 PTC Board Nominations
 - a. Nominations open 03/15-03/22; ballot emailed to families 03/23 with voting window until 03/25; announcement of board in 03/27 Friday Folder email and social media
 - i. Greta will send out email to current board members to gauge the interest of who is interested in returning next year
- 4. Teacher Appreciation -
 - a. Yolanda is working with Chilton TAW chair on March gift - a spring cup that has the teacher's name on it and filled with goodies (emergen-c packet, mint, gum, etc.)
 - b. The PTC will provide breakfast burritos (\$3 each) and coffee from Roadhouse Deli for staff the morning of 03/26 - last day of school before spring break. This was recently done for Chilton staff and went over very well. Tara loved the burritos! :)

Additional Items

1. Fifth grade grad tshirts– The 5th grade team decided on tshirt design and will not be doing lawn signs this year. Greta will help facilitate order with Just Print IT Ink.
2. Family Night – looking for a volunteer to lead planning efforts for an event in April after we return from Spring Break.
 - a. Pizza Night – Greta reached out to Campellis to see if they would be open to creating pizza kits we could sell and they were excited to partner with us. They charge \$9.95 a kit and we could add a redbox code to make it a family movie pizza night. Contact Greta if you are interested in leading this event.
 - b. Other options:
 - i. Tile painting event for planters at school – possible idea for next year. When Junction opened, students had a chance to purchase tile, paint it and have it out on the school planters. We have a new generation of Junction students now and they could help with playground g=refurbishment plans if there are planters with space available.
 - ii. Paint Night - Young Rembrandts have 2 options available: 1) pre-pay YR for an event and make the event link available to families or 2) families sign up directly through YR and pay them directly. These didn't quite fit with what we were looking to do at this time.
3. Yearbooks – Mrs. Mochrie is working with the front office staff to create a yearbook for this school year and seeking help from the PTC if any persons are interested. They need help uploading digital photos and creating a “shutterfly style” book. There is a tight turnaround time - mid April. Please reach out to Greta or Mrs. Mochrie if you can help.
